

NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS

LOWER YAHARA RIVER TRAIL (LYRT) TO BENEFIT ARBOR HILLS (AH) BICYCLISTS AND WALKERS

The LYRT Phase 1, presently under construction, is a 2.5 mile extension of the Capital City Trail south-east beyond the Lussier Family Heritage Center in Lake Farms Park to McDaniel Park in the Village of McFarland that is scheduled to be completed by July of 2017. Via the Capital City trail, the Lussier Center is approximately 7 miles from AH Park (Pelham and Derby Down). Thus, with completion of LYRT Phase 1, AH bikers will have a paved 10 mile ride that is almost entirely separate from motorized traffic from our community to the amenities and attractions of McFarland.

The LYRT promises to be amazing, including the longest (1.1 miles) continuous bicycle-pedestrian bridge and boardwalk system in the state that is designed to respect sensitive natural (wetland and lake habitats) and archeological (pre-historic Native-American) areas. The trail will also be beautiful, surrounded for substantial portions by Lake Waubesa and Upper Mud Lake.

Additionally, LYRT will also include punch-outs to allow fishing, resting and observing nature.

Furthermore, future phases of LYRT are destined to extend beyond McFarland to Fish Camp County Park, Lake Kegonsa State Park and onward to Viking Park in the City of Stoughton.
